

Miracles Making

In 2018 she received the Outstanding Business Leader award at UVU's Master of Business Administration graduation. Her love of sharing stories with the public continued to bloom, and she worked at the New Era magazine and the Deseret News before she and her husband, Matt, started their own magazine company in 2000. She and Matt are raising their publishing company in Orem and their five children in Pleasant Grove.

The UVU Green Man Group was founded in 2010 and has quickly become one of the university's best-loved traditions. 
